The Fellowship has been established to foster poetic and professional development of an individual within the wider poetic community, encouraging poets to undertake an intensive period of creative development involving a range of commissions, residency, recordings and publication outcomes.

The Red Room Poetry Fellowship is made possible with support from generous philanthropists.

The successful Fellow will receive:

- \$5000 poetic stipend "no strings"
- \$1000 commission to create a suite of poems inspired by an existing Red Room project
- A two-week residency at Bundanon Trust
- Travel assistance
- Paid professional employment (delivering up to 4 x poetic workshops)
- Opportunity to present a public address during the year-long Fellowship
- Highly visible publication of commissioned poem(s) on public transport
